Boulevard Beautification

Please do not pile sticks in the boulevards! Instead, put them in yard waste barrels for Sunday pick-up. The city will *eventually* pick up the sticks & fallen branches from the boulevards, but while they sit

there they could kill the grass underneath and the city will routinely mow around them.

Due to the cost of lawn care, professional maintenance of our boulevards focuses only on pre-emergent weed control and includes some fertilization and trimming of plants to repair winter damage. Additional care from residents can only improve on the beauty of our boulevards.

Monaca vs. Monoca

It should be noted that the street names of Frontier Place-Monaca Drive, Cherokee Drive, Shawnee Drive, Seminole Drive, and Mohawk Drive - are all American Indian names. You will find two accepted spellings of Monaca Drive: Monaca and Monoca. Monoca is not an American Indian name, but Monaca is.

Monaca comes from an Oneida Indian, Monacatootha.

The deeds of 20% of the 20 homes on Monaca use the spelling Monoca. The other 80% of the deeds use Monaca. U.S. Mail is delivered using both spellings. The preferred spelling is Monaca Drive, which we believe was the original intention of the developers and fits categorically with the other street names in the subdivision.
